

IT'S ALL TRUE 2011 ANNOUNCES SCREENINGS IN BRASÍLIA AND RECIFE

The 16th It's All True - International Documentary Film Festival organizes two important screenings in its 2011 schedule in Brasília and Recife. The two cities are therefore included in the festival schedule, which began on 31 March in São Paulo and 1 April in Rio de Janeiro.

On 10 April there will be another Première Cinemark screening of the film "Rio Sonata" by French filmmaker Georges Gachot, a documentary that reveals the life and career of one of the greatest Brazilian singers, Nana Caymmi. The screening will be at 9:30pm at Cinemark Shopping Pier.

On 13 April there will be a screening of the Brazilian winner of the CPFL Energia/IT'S ALL TRUE "Window to the Contemporary" at 8:00pm at Fundação Joaquim Nabuco in Recife. The award of R\$ 110,000 is given to Brazilian documentaries.
