

# 12th CONFERENCE EXAMINES "THE ANIMATED REALITY"

# Debates and films at Cinemateca Brasileira in SP from 28 to 30 March

In its 12th edition, the International Documentary Conference highlights the subject "THE ANIMATED REALITY - ANIMATION IN DOCUMENTARY FILM" this year. The idea is to address production that uses an innovative format - animation - to represent difficult and controversial real life facts and subjects.

A partnership that has existed with the It's All True Festival since 2001, the Conference is a privileged space for reflection about documentary production. The Brazilian and international scientific and artistic communities update each other on the paths that research and production are currently taking, in addition to discussing the most relevant issues of contemporary production.

Coordinated by Maria Dora Mourão, the Conference is realized once again in partnership with its host Cinemateca Brasileira, counting as always on the support of CINUSP "Paulo Emílio" and the School of Communication and Art of Universidade de São Paulo (ECA-USP). There will be four panels: "Animation as a Portrait of the Unconsicous" with the participation of English documentary filmmaker Andy Glynne; "Animation as a Portrait of Conflicts" with the participation of director and professor Oscar Andrade; "The Animation / Documentary Connection" with the Portuguese animator José Miguel Ribeiro and the American critic Michael Renov; and "The Expanded Documentary: Animation and Multimedia in Documentary Film" with the participation of essayist, curator and documentary filmmaker Andrés Di Tella, celebrated by the international retrospective of this year's festival.

Over the three days, documentaries that represent the setting discussed in these panels will be shown, like Andy Glynne's shorts and the feature "Waltz with Bashir" by Ari Folman. Check the panel and screening schedule below.
