OPENING NIGHT FILMS IN SP AND RIO

It's All True 2012 - 17th International Documentary Film Festival will open on 22 March at 9:30pm at Espaço Itaú de Cinema Pompeia in São Paulo with ***Tropicália***, a film by Marcelo Machado produced by Bossa Nova Films. The film digs into this important musical movement of the end of the 1960s led by Caetano Veloso and Gilberto Gil.

Through testimonies and archival images, the feature recovers a time in which the music scene simmered and music festivals, promoted by the television channels of the time, were important revelations of new talents. At the same time, the dictatorship was intensified by the generals in power.

Opening night in Rio will take place on the follow day, 23/03, at 9:30 pm at Espaço Itaú de Cinema Botafogo with ***Jorge Mautner - Child of the Holocaust*** directed by Pedro Bia and Heitor D'Alincourt. The documentary brings to light the work of this son of European immigrants who learned only three chords and realized an important body of work, revered by important names of music.

The opening nights of It's All True 2012 are exclusively for invited guests. The programs, however, will have later screenings for the general public.
